PETANQUE

1. RULES

The competition will be held in accordance with the rules of the Federation Internationale De Petanque Et Jeu Provencal (F.I.P.J.P.).

2. EVENT

Team's Event.

3. TECHNICAL ORGANIZATION

The technical committee of the 24th IMT-GT Varsity Carnival will be responsible for the technical organization of the competition. The decision of this committee in all matters regarding the tournament shall be final.

4. LAW OF THE GAME

The competition shall be conducted in accordance with the current rules of the game as approved by the Fédération Internationale de Pétanque et Jeu Provençal (F.I.P.J.P.).

5. NUMBER OF PLAYERS

- 5.1 Each team shall consist of not more than 4 players (2 men and 2 women)
- 5.2 Each player is allowed to participate in a single and mix doubles match.
- 5.3 Submit the Petanque players list 30 minutes before the competition.

6. POINTS IN GROUP COMPETITION

6.1 Method of points awarded

Win : 1 point

Lose : 0 points

- 6.2 If two (2) or more teams in the same group obtain an equal number of points then the ranking shall be decided on:
 - 6.2.1 Points of wins
 - 6.2.2 Points of event wins

- 6.2.3 Points earned minus points lost
- 6.2.4 Rematch 1 end. (Mix Double)

7. THE TIE

- 7.1 Each tie shall be competed in the following order.
 - 7.1.1 Men's Single
 - 7.1.2 Women's Single
 - 7.1.3 Mix Double
- 7.2 Competition system
 - 7.2.1 If 11 or more teams, divide into 4 groups (1 group not more than 3 teams)
 - 7.2.1.1 The champion and runner-up of the groups into the quarter final. (time limit 50 minutes + 1 end) 13 points, Mark Terrain.
 - 7.2.1.2 Final Match, no time limit, 13 points, Mark Terrain.
 - 7.2.1.3 Round-robin system competition is used in the first round. (time limit 50 minutes + 1 end) 13 points, Mark Terrain.
 - 7.2.2 If 10 or fewer teams, divide into 2 groups (1 group not more than 5 teams)
 - 7.2.2.1 The champion and runner-up of the groups into the semi-final. (time limit 50 minutes + 1 end) 13 points, Mark Terrain.
 - 7.2.2.2 Final Match, no time limit, 13 points, Mark Terrain.
 - 7.2.2.3 Round-robin system competition is used in the first round. (time limit 50 minutes + 1 end) 13 points, Mark Terrain.

8. ABANDONED MATCH

In the event of cancellation or unfinished matches due to unforeseen circumstances, the match shall be replayed, if possible. Otherwise, a toss of coin shall decide the winner.

9. JUDGING THE EVENTS

The necessary technical officials, referees, judges, umpires, time keepers or inspectors for sport shall be appointed by the appropriate National Sports Organization of the host nation.

10. INTERPRETATION

In the interpretation of the laws of games or the rules governing the Petanque tournament, if there is any disagreement, the English text shall be taken as authoritative.

11. MATTERS NOT PROVIDED FOR

All matters not provided for in the rules shall be dealt with by the games organizing committee whose decision is final.
