# **VOLLEYBALL (WOMEN'S)**

### 1. RULES

The competition will be held in accordance with the rules of the International Volleyball Federation (FIVB).

#### 2. EVENT

Women's team.

#### 3. TECHNICAL ORGANIZATION

The technical committee of the 24<sup>th</sup> IMT-GT Varsity Carnival will be responsible to the technical organization of the competition. The decision of this committee in all matters regarding the tournament shall be final.

## 4. LAW OF THE GAME

The competition shall be conducted in accordance with the current rules of the games as approved by the International Volleyball Federation (FIVB).

## 5. NUMBER OF PLAYERS

Each team shall consist of not more than 10 players.

## 6. POINTS IN GROUP COMPETITION

6.1 Method of points awarded

Win : 1 point Lose : 0 point

- 6.2 If two (2) or more teams in the same group obtain an equal number of points then the ranking shall be decided on :
  - 6.2.1 Higher set difference (sets won sets lost)
  - 6.2.2 Higher point difference in the sets competed (total points won total points lost)

- 6.2.3 In the event of a tie again, then the team that has defeated its opponent shall be ranked higher.
- 6.2.4 If the result is still tied, then a coin toss shall decide the winner.
- 6.3 The match shall be decided by the best of three (3) sets of 25 points.

#### 7. ABONDENED MATCH

If a match cannot be completed due to unforeseen circumstances, it shall be replayed if possible. Otherwise, a coin toss shall decide the winner.

## 8. WALK-OVER AND WITHDRAWAL

If a team failed to turn up for a match 15 minutes after the scheduled time, the opponents shall be awarded a walk-over with two (2) points.

## 9. JUDGING THE EVENTS

The necessary technical officials, referees, judges, umpires, time keepers or inspectors for sport shall be appointed by the appropriate National Sports Organization of the host nation.

#### 10. INTERPRETATION

In the interpretation of the laws of games or the rules governing the volleyball tournament, if there is any disagreement, the English text shall be taken authoritative.

#### 11. MATTERS NOT PROVIDED FOR

All matters not provided for in there rules shall be dealt with by the games organizing committee whose decision is final.
